REASONS: The current ttydim/355 software is inefficient, slow, difficult to extend, and often impossible for a user to "tune" to his own needs. It is proposed (See MTB-049) to replace this software.

SUMMARY: MTB-049 proposes that the 355 software be written to include device control (now done in 6180) and that the 6180 ttydim be moved out of ring-0. In addition several improvements and additions are suggested.

To the user, none other than new features. IMPLICATIONS: To Honeywell, however, there is the "NPS facilities will still exist. Phoenix has had difficulty with overflow of fixed-size tables which REASONS: are created in Collection 2 of initialization. Specifically, the IOAT and str_seg (segment trailer segment) have overflowed. The size of these tables can only be changed currently by recompilation of programs and regeneration of system tapes.

SUMMARY: A new configuration card (TBIS) is supplied at bootload time. This card (possibly more than one, if needed) supplies, as a sequence of pairs, TBLS IOAT 4 STR 6) the size of system tables. Defaults are supplied by the cur length attribute in the hardcore header.

REASONS: Most Multics sites do not currently perform post purging. However, there are some features of post purging which are useful and it is proposed to reestablish the default mode as post purge ON. However, the only features of post purging that will be enabled are the following:

- 1. the working set estimation
- 2. the moving of process directory pages to the head of the core map list so they appear least recently used.

Options at post purge time that will be available but not initially used are:

- 1. writing out of modified pages
- 2. turning off used bits.

SUMMARY: The subroutine post purge alm will be modified to reflect the changes te init will be changed to enable post purging as the default.

IMPLICATIONS: None that a site can not easily override. The trace of scheduling is done by post purge so that such trace entries will appear only if post purging is enabled.

REASONS: With the installation of the EIS operators about 5 more pages of core will be wired which needn't be. This is because of the design of the operator segment and its interface to the conversion and math library routines.

SUMMARY: Change update_sst_pl1 to wire pages up through pl1_operators_ but not the utility routines that follow it in the object segment.

IMPLICATIONS: Performance won't be as bad as it might otherwise be due to less pages being wired.
