Purpose

The echo command types out the character string which is passed to it as an argument. The character string is prefaced by "echo: ".

Usage

The user types the command line

echo string

where string is a character string. It may be a simple string, e.g.,

echo abc

a literal string, e.g.,

echo `typewriter output'

or an immediate-value command which has a character-string value, e.g.,

echo {wdir}

<u>Implementation</u>

The echo command concatenates "echo: " and its character-string argument, then calls write_out\$n1 (BY.4.02) with the resulting string.
